#### **Consideration of Approval – 2020 ANNUAL HUTF Road Mileage Certification**

Morgan County Information Systems Manager, Karol Kopetzky presented to the Board the 2020 Annual Road Mileage Certification. Ms. Kopetzky stated she worked with Public Works Director Bruce Bass on the mileage certification. Ms. Kopetzky outlined the information in detail regarding the report being presented which will be

submitted to the State of Colorado. Ms. Kopetzky stated the County is certifying to the State 1,030.089 miles 307.056 miles which are arterial streets and 723.033 miles which are local streets, of those miles, 212.910 are paved roads and 817.179 are unpaved roads. Ms. Kopetzky also provided details regarding the projects that were completed in 2020 by the road and bridge department.

**WHEREAS**, Walter Thomas Jones (Owner) owns property located in the SW <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SW <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Morgan County, Colorado, also known as 17024 County Road 2, Wiggins, Colorado 80654 (Property);

**WHEREAS**, Owner, has applied for approval of a minor subdivision of the Property into two lots pursuant to the County's Subdivision Regulations (Application);

**WHEREAS**, on December 9, 2019, the Morgan County Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on the application where they received public comment, staff input and recommended conditional approval of the Application;

**WHEREAS**, on February 2, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) held a duly noticed public hearing on the Application;

**WHEREAS**, during the public hearing, the Board received testimony and evidence from the Owner, Morgan County staff and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to approve the Application, subject to the conditions below.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:**

1. The Board, having reviewed the application, all information provided and testimony heard, finds that:
  - a. The application documents are complete and represent how the subdivision will be laid out including infrastructure, easements and access.
  - b. The subdivision is in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan and there is access to established public infrastructure.
  - c. The subdivision is compatible with surrounding land uses.

Morgan County Planning and Zoning Planning Administrator, Pam Cherry, presented to the Board Resolution 2021 BCC 08, a Resolution Granting a Two Lot Minor Subdivision, known as the Jones Minor Subdivision, Located In The SW¼ Of The SW¼ Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 60 West Of The 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Morgan County, Colorado. Ms. Cherry stated that on December 9, 2019, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on an application from Walter Thomas Jones, for a two-lot minor subdivision – Jones Minor Subdivision located in the SW¼ of the SW¼ Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Morgan County, Colorado, also known as 17024 County Road 2, Wiggins, Colorado 80654.

Ms. Cherry stated that on February 2, 2021 the Board of County Commissioners considered the application in public hearings and approved the application. Resolution 2021 BCC 08 reflects the outcome of the hearing.

Commissioner Becker made the motion to approve Resolution 2021 BCC 08, a Resolution Granting a Two Lot Minor Subdivision, known as the Jones Minor Subdivision, Located In The SW¼ Of The SW¼ Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 60 West Of The 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Morgan County, Colorado, as outlined by the Morgan County Planning and Zoning Planning Administrator, Pam Cherry, signing nunc pro tunc February 2, 2021. Commissioner Westhoff seconded the motion. **RESOLUTION NO. 2021 BCC 09**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MORGAN COUNTY LIQUOR LICENSING AND PERMITTING REGULATIONS REGARDING INCREASING THE FINES FOR VIOLATIONS AND ALLOWING FOR A PERMITTING PROCEDURE FOR TAKE OUT AND DELIVERY PERMITS**

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly recently passed Senate Bill 20-110 which, among other things, requires an increase in the fine amount for liquor violations;

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly additionally passed Senate Bill 20-213, which allows local licensing authorities to create a permit system for the takeout and delivery of alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to amend the County's established liquor licensing regulations to correspond with state law and to create a takeout and delivery permit.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

Section 1. Section X(E) of the Morgan County Local Licensing Authority Regulation is hereby amended to read as follows:

X. Suspension and Revocation.

E. The fine in lieu shall be equivalent to twenty percent (20%) of the licensee's estimated gross revenues from sales of alcohol beverages during the period of the proposed suspension; except that the fine must be between \$500.00 and \$100,000.00.

Section 2. The Morgan County Liquor Licensing and Permitting Regulations are hereby amended with the addition of a new Section XV entitled "Take Out and Delivery Permits" to read as follows:

XV. Take Out and Delivery Permits.

A. Unless the Governor has issued a disaster emergency under Part 7 of Article 33.5 of Title 24, C.R.S., no person issued a license under Sections 44-3-411, 44-3-413, 44-3-414, 44-3-417, 44-3-418, 44-3-422, 44-3-426, 44-3-428, 44-4-104 (1)(c)(I)(A), OR 44-4-104 (1)(c)(III), C.R.S., may sell alcohol beverages through takeout or delivery pursuant to 44-3-911, C.R.S., unless the licensee has first obtained a permit from the state licensing authority and local licensing authority and paid the relevant fee. If a licensee subject to this Subsection applies for a takeout and delivery permit while a Governor declared disaster emergency is in effect, the licensee may continue engaging in takeout and delivery until the disaster emergency is rescinded or expired.

B. An applicant for a permit must affirm on its application for a takeout and delivery permit that the applicant derives, or will derive, no more than fifty (50) percent of its gross annual revenues from total sales of food and alcohol beverages from the sale of alcohol beverages through takeout orders and orders that the licensee delivers. However, the 50% limit

shall not apply if the Governor has issued a disaster emergency under Part 7 of Article 33.5 of Title 24, C.R.S.

C. A takeout and delivery permittee shall display its takeout and delivery permit at all times in a prominent place on its licensed premises. The takeout and delivery permittee's employee making a delivery shall be required to carry, or have immediate access to, a copy of the takeout and delivery permit in the delivery vehicle. The copy of the permit may be electronic.

D. A person authorized to engage in sales of alcohol beverages through a takeout and delivery permit must comply with the following requirements and limitations:

1. Orders for delivery or takeout that includes alcohol beverages may be accepted only by the licensee or its employees at the licensed premises. Orders may be accepted by telephone, in person, or via internet communication. No order for delivery may be solicited or accepted by a delivery driver from a delivery vehicle. All orders for delivery shall be documented in a written order prepared by the licensee or its employees.

2. When receiving a delivery order, the licensee must obtain and record the name and date of birth of the person placing the order and the delivery address for the order. No person under the age of twenty-one (21) may place an order for the takeout or delivery of alcohol beverages.

3. Delivery of orders that include alcohol beverages shall be made only to a person twenty-one (21) years of age or older at the address specified in the customer's delivery order.

4. Delivery of orders that include alcohol beverages shall not be made to any public place, including public parks, streets, alleys, roads, or highways.

5. Delivery must be made by an employee of the licensee who is at least twenty-one (21) years of age, and who has completed a seller server training program. Use of third-party delivery services is prohibited.

6. The licensee's employee who delivers the alcohol beverages shall note and log at the time of delivery the name and date of birth of the person receiving the delivery of the alcohol beverages. Under no circumstances shall a person under twenty-one (21) years of age be permitted to receive a delivery of alcohol beverages

7. Licensees who deliver alcohol beverages shall maintain all records relating to delivery, including delivery orders, receipt logs and journals. These records shall be maintained by the licensee for the current and three prior calendar years.

8. Licensees engaged in delivery shall comply with state and local laws, ordinances or regulations, addressing prohibitions on open containers of alcohol beverages in motor vehicles.

9. Any alcohol beverage sold to a consumer through delivery or takeout, including cocktails or mixed drinks must be in a sealed container. "Sealed container" has the same definition as it does in C.R.S. § 44-3-103(51), and additionally includes a rigid container that contains a cocktail or mixed drink, or other alcohol beverage poured into a container by a licensee that is new, has never been used, has a secure lid or cap designed to prevent consumption without removal of the lid or cap, and is tamper evident. "Sealed container" does not include a container with a lid with sipping holes or openings for straws or a container made of paper or polystyrene foam. "Tamper evident" means a lid or cap that has been sealed with tamper-evident material, including but not limited to, wax dip, heat shrink wrap, or adhesive tape or other material, designed to reveal the removal or opening of the lid, cap, or seal. Licensees may not refill sealed containers or offer any refilled containers for sale.

10. Any sealed containers sold for takeout or delivery, other than beverages sealed by its manufacturer, must be affixed with an adhesive sticker identifying the licensee that sold the beverage and containing a warning statement with a minimum of 14 font size stating, "WARNING: DO NOT OPEN OR REMOVE SEAL WHILE IN TRANSIT. Purchasers are subject to state and local laws and regulations prohibiting drinking or possessing open containers of alcoholic beverages in motor vehicles, including section 42-4-1305, C.R.S."

11. Licensees who sell alcohol beverages through delivery or takeout pursuant to this regulation are responsible for compliance with all laws and regulations prohibiting the sale of alcohol beverages to an underage person or to a visibly intoxicated person.

E. Unless the Governor has declared a disaster emergency under Part 7 of Article 33.5 of Title 24, C.R.S., no person licensed under 44-3-411, 44-3-413, 44-3-414, 44-3-418, 44-3-428, 44-4-104(1)(c)(I)(A), OR 44-4-104(1)(c)(III), C.R.S., shall sell more than the following amounts of alcohol beverage to a consumer as part of a takeout or delivery order:

1. 750 milliliters, or approximately 26.4 fluid ounces, of spirituous and vinous liquors; and
2. 72 fluid ounces, or approximately 2046 milliliters, of malt liquor, fermented malt beverages, and hard cider.

F. This Section XV is repealed, effective July 1, 2021, and any takeout and delivery permit then in effect shall be deemed to have expired, without any further action of the local licensing authority. However, if the State extends the state licensing authority's ability to issue takeout and delivery permits or the validity of permits already issued past this date, then this Section shall be equally extended.

Morgan County Attorney, Kathryn Sellars, presented to the Board Resolution 2021 BCC 09, a Resolution Amending The Morgan County Liquor Licensing And Permitting Regulations Regarding Increasing The Fines For Violations And Allowing For A Permitting Procedure For Take Out And Delivery Permits. Ms. Sellars stated this resolution does two things there were several changes to liquor laws in the last legislative session one was the increase in fines from \$200 up to \$5,000.00 to \$500.00 up to - \$100,000.00 which brings the County into compliance with state law. Ms. Sellars explained the second part of the resolution is the permit system for takeout and delivery of alcohol. There will be a State and County permit that applicants will have to apply for if they choose to have takeout and delivery of alcohol. Ms. Sellars stated that this only applies when there is no disaster emergency in place. This permitting only comes into place when the Governor's emergency order declaration is expired and is only effective until July 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 however, she does see that it will more than likely be extended.

Commissioner Jon Becker asked for clarification on the fining issues that the wording could be changed from shall to may, with Ms. Sellars stating that the Commissioners do not have discretion over that wording because it is state statute. Ms. Sellars explained that if a licensee does not want their liquor licenses suspended or revoked they can ask for a fee in lieu. Chairman Arndt stated that Morgan County is not looking to fine anyone, they are just following state statute.

Commissioner Westhoff made the motion to approve Resolution 2021 BCC 09, a Resolution Amending The Morgan County Liquor Licensing And Permitting Regulations Regarding Increasing The Fines For Violations And Allowing For A Permitting Procedure For Take Out And Delivery Permits as outlined by the Morgan County Attorney, Kathryn Sellars. Commissioner Becker seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.

### Consideration of Approval – 2021 BCC 10 A Resolution Establishing An Emergency Telephone Charge

#### RESOLUTION NO. 2021 BCC 10

#### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY TELEPHONE CHARGE

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-11-102(2)(a), the Board of County Commissioners are authorized to impose emergency telephone charge on service users with an address in the County;

WHEREAS, the Board may impose an emergency telephone charge up to the amount authorized by the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC");

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2020, the PUC established the new annual threshold rate for the emergency telephone charge as \$1.72;

WHEREAS, the County provides emergency telephone service, or 911 service, through its Communication Center;

WHEREAS, the emergency telephone charge has not increased since 1990 and the costs of providing these services have continued to increase;

WHEREAS, providing emergency telephone service enhances the response time of emergency responders such as law enforcement agencies, ambulance service, and fire protection; and

WHEREAS, it promotes the health, safety, and welfare of all citizens of Morgan County to provide emergency telephone service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

Section 1. A monthly charge of one dollar and seventy-two cents (\$1.72) per 911 access connection to fund the costs incurred by the County for equipment, installation, and other directly related costs for the continued operation of an emergency telephone service is hereby imposed.

Section 2. Notice shall be given to every service supplier of the emergency telephone charge imposed by this Resolution.

Morgan County Communications Center Director, Danette Martin, presented to the Board Resolution 2021 BCC 10, a Resolution Establishing An Emergency Telephone Charge. Ms. Martin stated this will be for the 911 fund. Ms. Martin stated the cost of running a 911 center has increased dramatically in the past several years and those increased expenses cannot be sustained with the current surcharge of \$.70 cents per device. Ms. Martin stated that the surcharge has not been increased since 1990. Ms. Martin explained that in July 2020 the telephone system had to be updated; as a result the monthly Century Link bill went from \$845.00 to \$3,200.00. Ms. Martin explained that each of the municipalities in the County will have to adopt a resolution to increase the new charge. Ms. Martin noted that there is urgency to get this done, as there is limited timeframes of when the surcharges can be changed, and if it does not get approved now it won't be able to be addressed again until February 2022.

At this time, Ms. Martin asked for the Board to approve the resolution to increase the surcharge from \$.70 cents to \$1.72.

Commissioner Becker asked for explanation of what the surcharge is used for, and reassurance that it is not a fund that just sits there. Ms. Martin explained that the surcharge is used for telephone system upgrades and there are 5.25 salaries being paid as well. Ms. Martin stated that if the surcharge stays at \$.70, they will be in the red, and is recommending that it is increased to \$1.72. Commissioner Becker noted that the surcharge is looked at every year, so that if the \$1.72 is more than what is needed it can be adjusted, with Ms. Martin stating that is correct. Chairman Arndt said that the 911 funds are very restrictive and must be used for 911 services only, which is becoming more costly the more that technology advances with using services like texting 911 and increased use of cell phones.

Commissioner Becker made the motion to approve Resolution 2021 BCC 10, a Resolution Establishing An Emergency Telephone Charge as outlined by the Morgan Communications Center Director, Danette Martin. Commissioner Westhoff seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.
