Morgan County Finance Director Michelle Covelli presented to the Board for approval, Resolution 2017 BCC 56, a resolution to adopt the 2018 budget. Ms. Covelli thanked all department heads and elected officials for their assistance with the budget and explained the process that is used starting in July. She further summarized the 2018 Budget Highlight as follows:

The 2018 budget total is \$38,725,675. This is a decrease of \$3,435,283 from the 2017 budget.

The budget is balanced. Total property tax revenue is \$15,994,172. Total revenue from other sources is \$19,355,603 and total from fund balance is \$3,375,900. The decrease in fund balance is due to capital projects budgeted for 2018. The County's total capital budget is \$6,964,411.

The assessed value is \$552,170,540. This is an increase of \$30,998,360 (6%).

The total mill levy to be certified by the County is 28.966. The total mill includes a .018 mill to be certified due to prior year tax abatements. Total property tax revenue budgeted is \$15,994,172. This is an increase of \$895,814.

County health insurance premiums went up 6% for an increase of approximately \$150,000 in premiums. The total premiums the County will pay for health insurance premiums for 2018 is approximately \$2.7 million.

The County salary structure is increased by 7%. This increased the total budget approximately \$700,000.

General Fund budget is \$15,822,431. This includes a capital project budget of \$1,870,000. This includes \$1.2 million for the roof at the Justice Center. The 2018 budget is an increase of approximately \$1.9 million from 2017 budget.

Road and Bridge Fund budget is \$8,211,054. This includes a capital project budget of \$1,836,111 including new asphalt on CR 24 from W to Y. This is a decrease in total budget of approximately \$2.7 million from 2017.

Social Services 2018 budget is \$5,381,249. This is an increase of \$211,000 from 2017.

911 Emergency Telephone Fund budget is \$833,500. This includes \$670,600 for capital projects. This is an increase of \$19,500 from 2017.

Lodging and Tourism Fund budget is \$213,388. This is a decrease of \$151,799 from 2017.

Conservation Trust Fund budget is \$148,000. This includes \$90,000 in capital projects. This is a decrease of \$332,000 from 2017 budget.

Confiscation Seizure Fund budget is \$10,000.

Jail Capital Improvement Fund budget is \$500,000. This is an increase of \$400,000 from the 2017 budget. The budget includes a new security system at the jail.

Ambulance Service Budget is \$1,513,291. This includes \$250,000 in capital projects. This is a decrease of \$181,504 from 2017 budget.

Solid Waste Management Fund budget is \$1,075,761. This includes \$45,000 in capital projects. This is a decrease of \$1,559,038 from 2017.

Central Services Fund budget is \$5,016,701. This includes capital projects totaling \$1,703,300. This is a decrease of \$1,051,962 from the 2017 budget.

Ms. Covelli stated the budget is balanced and at this time, she asked the Commissioners to approve the resolution to adopt the 2018 budget.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Resolution 2017 BCC 56, a resolution to adopt the 2018 budget as presented by Morgan County Finance Director Michelle Covelli with Chairman Zwetzig seconding the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Morgan has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 12, 2017, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the general operating purposes General Fund is \$10,748,552 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Road and Bridge Fund is \$4.141.279, and:

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Social Services Fund is \$1,104,341, and;

WHEREAS, the 2017 valuation for assessment for the County of Morgan as certified by the County Assessor is \$522,170,540

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MORGAN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating and other expenses of General Fund of the County

of Morgan during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 19.466 mills upon each dollar of the total

valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2017.

Section 2. That for the purpose of meeting all operating and other expenses of the Road and Bridge Fund of the County of Morgan during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 7.500 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2017.

Section 3. That for the purpose of meeting all operating and other expenses of the Social Services Fund of the County of Morgan during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 2.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2017.

Morgan County Finance Director Michelle Covelli presented to the Board for approval, Resolution 2017 BCC 57, a resolution to set the mill levies. She summarized the mill levy explaining the tax abatement that will be included as outlined in the resolution. She stated this produces revenue in the amount of \$15,994.172.00 which is an increase in the amount of \$895,814.00. At this time, Ms. Covelli asked the Board to set the mill levy at 28.966 for the 2018 budget.

 - The variance is required to maintain and expand operations for Morgan County Quality Water District
 - b. The variance is required for continued truck operations at the facility. If the variance is not granted, the Applicant will be unable to use some of its property for truck loading and unloading.
 - c. Granting the variance will not be detrimental to the public good.

Morgan County Planning Director/Floodplain Administrator Pam Cherry presented to the Board for approval, Resolution 2017 BCC 59, a Resolution approving a variance for the construction of a storage shed on property located in the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 57 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado with an address of 17586 County Road 20, Fort Morgan, Colorado. Ms. Cherry stated this Resolution No. 2017 BCC 59 is for Morgan County Quality Water to construct a storage shed at 17586 County Road 20. This application was heard by the Board on November 21, 2017 and was approved for a variance to Section 3-650 Table 1 of Appendix B. The required setback on the north side of the property is ten feet in the commercial zone district; the request was to reduce it to three feet. The commissioners unanimously approved the request. Ms. Cherry asked for approval and signatures on the presented resolution.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Resolution 2017 BCC 59, a resolution approving a variance for the construction of a storage shed on property located in the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 57 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado for Morgan County Quality Water District with an address of 17586 County Road 20, Fort Morgan, Colorado as presented by Morgan County Planning Director/Floodplain Administrator Pam Cherry, approving the matter, nunc pro tunc, with Chairman Zwetzig seconding the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval - Morgan County Salary Structure

Morgan County Human Resources Director Tracy Amen presented to the Board for approval the Morgan County salary structure. Ms. Amen thanked everyone for the work that has been made in the efforts of improving the salaries employees receive. There has been a seven percent increase made across the salary line as a whole which will commence January 1, 2018.

Chairman Zwetzig made mention that some of the structures were already put into place and others will be made effective January 1st, 2018, with Ms. Amen stating that all department heads will need to complete payroll change forms for those positions this will affect. Chairman Zwetzig stated the Board has made the attempt and effort to bring the salaries to market level as best it can.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve the Morgan County salary structure as presented by Morgan County Human Resources Director Tracy Amen with Chairman Zwetzig seconding the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Chairman Zwetzig made mention of the festivities that are being held today for all those in the Administration Building to participate, and indicated it includes food!

COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated December 8, 2017 through December 19, 2017 with changes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2017 PMT 43 – Morgan County Quality Water District

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, as drafted, a Right of Way Permit 2017 PMT 43, indicating this was a permit that had been tabled from last week's meeting. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is to bore across County Road 16 and trench County Road S, starting at a point in the west right of way of County Road 16 and north right of way of County Road S boring under County Road 16 into the east right of way County Road 16 and the north right of way of County Road S; then trenching east in the north right of way of County Road S, 5,280 feet to connect to an existing 10 inch main A.C. in the West right of way of County Road 17, for the purpose of installing a 4 inch water main. The permit further indicates two trenches in the north right of way of County Road S, starting at a point approximately 1,800 feet East of County Road 16 in the north right of way of County Road S, at the above described 4 inch main line, trenching north to the north right of way of County Road S, at the above described 4 inch main line, trenching north to the north right of way of County Road S, at the above described 4 inch main line, trenching north to the north right of way line, for the purpose of installing two 3/4 inch water service lines.

Mr. Goodman indicated the fees are attached and the location has been inspected. Discussion followed with Chairman Zwetzig indicating the two bores under County Road S need to be removed, stating the reasons why. He further indicated the bore on County Road 16 needs to be completed, but the bore on County Road 17 does not, it will only require a trench on the right of way on the north side. Chairman Zwetzig also noted that there will also need to be information regarding the size of the pipe will be ¾ inch not 1.5 inch and it will go from the main 4 inch line to the north right of way of the property, indicating it will not be right on the north right of way, and that those will be trenched to the north right of way to get onto the private property.

At 1800 feet and 2075 trenching in the north right of way, the north line of the north right of way and the narrative of the permit will be amended to reflect the changes. Two ¾ lines to the taps, instead of the 1½ inch line will need to be noted. Chairman Zwetzig reviewed the fees, indicating the fees are correct as submitted. The narrative is correct except for the bores and there needs to be an addition regarding the trench.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2017 PMT 43 with Morgan County Quality Water District, to perform work as outlined in the narrative of the permit with the correction removing the two bores

across County Road S, and a trench performed at 1,800 feet and 2,075feet east of County Road 16, to attach the two main lines, noting the fees in the amount of \$678.00 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign. Chairman Zwetzig seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Re-Consider – Applicant/Landowner: Wesley Challis – Application for a Variance to the Bulk Regulations related to setbacks in the Agriculture Production zone district.

Morgan County Planning Director/Floodplain Administrator Pam Cherry presented to the Board for approval, a variance application for Wesley Challis. Ms. Cherry stated that the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on a variance request by Wesley Challis on November 28, 2017 and continued the hearing until December 12, 2017. The applicant has requested that the application be withdrawn. Ms. Cherry referenced a letter which is a part of the record requesting the withdrawal of the application.

Commissioner Teague made note about the permits approved last week for Wiggins Farms, as to the verification of these as being only crossings and there are no parallel right of way work to be considered. Chairman Zwetzig asked that the minutes reflect this coordination between last week's minutes to what has transpired up through this week's minutes to reflect the actual permit requirements.

Dave Martin, Undersheriff, thanked the Commissioners and the Finance Department for their efforts in increasing salaries for the employees.

CITIZEN'S COMMENT

Dave Martin thanked the Board for allowing him to use their building yesterday to announce that he is running for Morgan County Sheriff.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:31 a.m.
