### GENERAL BUSINESS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

#### **Consideration of Approval – RFP 2021-0408-001 Rotary Cutter Tabulation and Award**

Morgan County Public Works Director, Bruce Bass, presented to the Board for approval Tabulation and Award RFP 2021-0408-001 Rotary Cutter. Mr. Bass stated he received six bids, a bid from 21<sup>st</sup> Century Equipment LLC, for a John Deere, a bid from G&M Implement Inc., for a Rhino, a bid from Wickham Tractor Co., for a Landpride, a bid from High Plains New Holland, for a Wood's, a bid from Wagner Equipment Co., for a Wagner Equipment and a bid from Postestio Brothers Equipment, Inc., for a Shulte,. He further summarized the individual bids submitted.

# 2 COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Discussion followed regarding specific questions the board had regarding the bids submitted and this being a new vendor and a new product the County has not used in the past.

At this time, Mr. Bass recommended the bid be awarded to Postestio Brothers Equipment, Inc., for a Shulte in the amount of \$16,310.00 as submitted indicating this vendor did submit the lowest bid. Mr. Bass explained that Wickham Tractor's bid is within the five percent allowance for local vendors; however, the deck gauge is not within the bid spec. Mr. Bass and James Monroe, Morgan County Shop Manager both agree with this recommendation.

Commissioner Westhoff made a motion to approve RFP 2021-0408-0001 Rotary Cutter Bid Tabulation and Award to Postestio Brothers Equipment, Inc., for a Shulte in the amount of \$16,310.00 as recommended by Morgan County Public Works Director Bruce Bass, with Commissioner Becker seconding the motion. MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, Raul Delgadillo (“Delgadillo”) owns Lot 2 of the Pickens West Minor Subdivision, also known as 17696 County Road 15, Fort Morgan, Colorado 80701 and as shown on the plat for the Pickens West Minor Subdivision, recorded at reception number 1500190 in the records of the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder;

**WHEREAS**, Joshua Duane and Ashley Nicole Bristol (the “Bristols”) own Lot 1 of the Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision, also known as 17594 County Road 15, Fort Morgan, Colorado 80701 and as shown on the Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision, a replat of Lots 3 and 4 of the Pickens West Minor Subdivision, recorded at reception number 1500451 in the records of the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder;

**WHEREAS**, Matthew and Tiffany Wulf (the “Wulfs”) own Lot 2 of the Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision, also known as 17792 County Road 15, Lot #3, Fort Morgan, Colorado 80701 and as shown on the Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision, a replat of Lots 3 and 4 of the Pickens West Minor Subdivision, recorded at reception number 1500451 in the records of the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder;

**WHEREAS**, the Wulfs, Bristols and Delgadillo (collectively, “Owners”) have applied for a replat of Lots 1 and 2 of the Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision and Lot 2 of the Pickens West Minor Subdivision to adjust the boundary lines between the lots (the “Application”);

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2021, the Morgan County Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on the Application where they received public comment, staff input and recommended approval of the Application;

**WHEREAS**, on April 6, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) held a duly noticed public hearing on the Application;

**WHEREAS**, during the public hearing, the Board received testimony and evidence from the Owners, Morgan County staff and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to approve the Application.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:**

1. The Board, having reviewed the Application, all information provided and testimony heard, finds that:
  - a. The replat complies with these standards and regulations, and the original conditions of approval.
  - b. Nonconforming lots are not created, and in the case of nonconforming lots, the nonconformity is not increased.
  - c. The replat is in keeping with the purpose and intent of the County's Subdivision Regulations.
  - d. Legal and physical access is provided to all parcels by public rights-of-way or recorded easement, acceptable to the County in compliance with the County's Subdivision Regulations.

- e. The approval will not adversely affect the public health, safety, and welfare.

Morgan County Planning and Zoning Planning Administrator, Pam Cherry, presented to the Board Resolution 2021 BCC 14, a Resolution Granting A Replat, To Be Known As The Tradesman Minor Subdivision, And More Specifically A Replat Of Lot 2, Pickens West Minor Subdivision And Lots 1 And 2, Pickens West No. 2 Minor Subdivision, Located In The W½ Of NW¼ Of Section 3, Township 3 North, Range 58 West Of The 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Ms. Cherry stated that on March 8, 2021, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on an application for a Minor Subdivision to be known as Tradesman Minor Subdivision a replat of:

# 4 COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

**WHEREAS**, Daniel L. and Sharon K. Kauffman (the “Owners”) own property located in the NE¼ of Section 9, Township 3 North, Range 57 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, more particularly described 16985 County Road 21, Fort Morgan, Colorado 80701 (“Property”);

**WHEREAS**, the Owners have applied for a special use permit for a winery, including storage, a sales room, tastings and events (the “Application”) to be located on the Property;

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2021, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved;

**WHEREAS**, on April 6, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted at the Property;

**WHEREAS**, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Applicant and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application.

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:**

**1. APPROVAL.**

The Application is hereby granted. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this “Resolution” or the “Permit”).

**2. FINDING OF FACT.**

The following findings are made:

- a. The use and location are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. Specifically:
  - i. The project will broaden the employment opportunities for residents and will further economic growth. This project will support economic development by expanding agricultural processing in the County.
  - ii. The proposed use is compatible with existing land uses and there is access to established public infrastructure. This project is located adjacent to existing infrastructure, roads and Morgan County Quality Water.
  - iii. The use preserves the manmade and natural environment in order to enhance the quality of life in Morgan County and to make environment consideration part of the land use decision-making process.
- b. The application is complete and presents a clear picture of how the use is to be arranged on the site.
- c. The site conforms to the district design standards of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures.
- e. The special use is compatible with surrounding uses and is adequately buffered from any incompatible uses by distance and topography.
- f. This special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare, subject to the conditions below.
- g. The special use will not be located on a nonconforming parcel of land.
- h. The Applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project in the form of increased economic development. The Applicant has submitted all pertinent technical information, has demonstrated that it has adequate financial resources to implement the project, and has paid all County fees and review costs.
- i. The Applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability.

**2. GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

- a. The special use permit area shall be the exempted parcel of 5.67 acres as shown on the Exemption Plat recorded at reception number 1500516 in the records of the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder.

- b. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Owners.
- c. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.
- d. The Owners shall comply and ensure compliance by third parties with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.
