**A RESOLUTION GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR A SOLAR ENERGY FACILITY ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE N½ OF THE SW¼, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 56 W OF THE 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., MORGAN COUNTY COLORADO, ALSO KNOWN AS 18712 COUNTY ROAD 26, BRUSH, COLORADO 80723**

**WHEREAS**, the Terry L. Larsen Trust and Anna M. Larsen Trust (the “Owners”) own property located in the N½ of the SW¼, Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 56 W, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, more particularly described 18712 County Road 26, Brush, Colorado 80723 (“Property”);

**WHEREAS**, Pivot Energy (the “Applicant”) has applied for a special use permit for a solar energy facility (the “Application”) to be located on the Property;

**WHEREAS**, on April 12, 2021, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved;

**WHEREAS**, on May 4, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted at the Property;

**WHEREAS**, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Applicant and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application, subject to certain conditions set forth herein.

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:**

**1. APPROVAL.**

The Application is hereby granted, subject to the terms herein. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this "Resolution" or the "Permit").

**2. FINDING OF FACT.**

Subject to the Owners meeting and complying with all conditions set forth herein, the following findings are made:

- a. The use and location are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. Specifically:
  - i. This project will diversify the economy in Morgan County to broaden business employment opportunities for residents and to further economic growth by generating additional property taxes without a strain on public resources. To the extent possible, the developer of the project will hire local contractors throughout construction and the life of the project.
  - ii. The project encourages development on property that is not viable for agricultural use and is an ideal use for property located close to I-76.
  - iii. This project will not require the use of water, sewage or telecommunications onsite and will connect directly into Xcel Energy's existing electrical infrastructure on the west side of the parcel.
  - iv. The project will not impact wetlands, floodplains or drainage patterns.
- b. The application is complete and presents a clear picture of how the use is to be arranged on the site.
- c. The site conforms to the district design standards of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures. During construction and when necessary water trucks will be used for dust mitigation. Upon completion of the project, the site will be reseeded with a native low-growth prairie grass mix. Landscaping maintenance will occur on a regular basis during the growing season.
- e. The special use is compatible with surrounding uses and is adequately buffered from any incompatible uses by distance and topography. The closest residences to the facility are more than 500' to the south and already are buffered by the existence of trees along the northern boundaries of those properties.
- f. This special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare, subject to the conditions below. A solar glare analysis was completed using the industry standard for studying glare impacts. Eastbound and westbound traffic on I-76 from County Road 25, northbound and southbound traffic on County Road 26, traffic along residential roads as well as glare from 33 observation points or nearby residences were evaluated in the analysis. No instances of glare were anticipated by the project. The project will have minimal impacts on surrounding adjacent uses as the facility is unstaffed, generates no emissions, emits no light or discernible noise.
- g. The special use will not be located on a nonconforming parcel of land.
- h. The Applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project in the form of increased economic development. The Applicant has submitted all pertinent technical information, has demonstrated that it has adequate financial resources to implement the project, and has paid all County fees and review costs. The energy generated from this project will be injected into Xcel Energy's existing electrical infrastructure along County Road 26 and will provide cost savings to participating electrical customers as part of Xcel Energy's Solar Rewards Community program.

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- i. This project will not require a water supply.

### 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Owners.
- b. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.
- c. The Owners shall comply and ensure compliance by third parties with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.

Morgan County Planning and Zoning Planning Administrator, Pam Cherry, presented to the Board Resolution 2021 BCC 19, a A Resolution Granting A Special Use Permit For A Solar Energy Facility On The Property Located In The N½ Of The SW¼, Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 56 W Of The 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County Colorado, Also Known As 18712 County Road 26, Brush, Colorado 80723. Ms. Cherry stated that on April 12, 2021, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on an application from Pivot Energy to permit the construction of a solar energy system. The property is owned by Terry L. Larsen Trust and Anna M. Larsen Trust. The property is located in the N½ of the SW¼ of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 56 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Brush, Colorado 80723. The Planning Commission recommended approval on a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed with one member absent. On May 4, 2021 the Board of County Commissioners considered the application and approved it unanimously. Resolution 2021 BCC 19 reflects the outcome of that hearing.
