Also present was County Clerk Susan Bailey, County Attorney Kathryn Sellars and Planning and Zoning Administrative Assistant Jody Meyer. Chairman Pro Tem Becker asked Planning and Zoning Administrative Assistant Jody Meyer to lead the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Zwetzig made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented, with Chairman Pro Tem Becker seconding the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Pro Tem Becker called the hearing to order at 9:01 a.m. in the Assembly Room of the Morgan County Administration Building. 1. Colorado Liberty Pipeline as Applicant Various landowners along Co Rd A through Co Rd 24 in Morgan and Adams County for a Special Use Permit to place 24" crude oil pipeline

Chairman Pro Tem Becker opened the hearing asking for comment from the applicant at which time, Jason Brinkly, legal counsel for the applicant spoke stating they have no issues with moving the scheduled hearing to a future date. Chad Polak, applicant, stated they look forward to the hearing being rescheduled for June 9, 2020.
