The Board of Morgan County Commissioners met Tuesday, June 16, 2020 at 9:13 a.m. with Chairman Mark Arndt, Commissioner Jon Becker and Commissioner James Zwetzig in attendance.

CITIZEN'S COMMENT

There was no citizen comment provided.

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Zwetzig made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented, with Commissioner Becker seconding the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve items 1-7 as presented, Commissioner Zwetzig seconded the motion. At this time the motion carried 3-0.

GENERAL BUSINESS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Consideration Of Approval – Jackson Lake Fireworks, application submitted by Margaret Journey, President of Pirate Pyrotechnics

Morgan County Administrative Services Manager, Karla Powell presented the application submitted by Margaret Journey for Jackson Lake Village for a Fireworks Display Permit on July 4, 2020. The address for the fireworks display will take place is 25402 County Road 3 Lot 82, Weldona CO 80653. Ms. Powell stated Ms. Journey has provided the necessary application for this permit with notations regarding the liability insurance requirement. Ms. Powell read into the record the letter submitted by Ms. Journey.

Chairman Arndt stated for the record that Ms. Journey and Tyler Seewald from Jackson Lake State Park are attending the meeting via Zoom also with Morgan County Sheriff Dave Martin in person.

Ms. Journey stated that the directors of Jackson Lake Property Owners Association did have their meeting and have approved the firework display. Mr. Seewald stated he had a few concerns if there is a fire ban will the firework display be canceled and that fireworks are not shot over the wildlife area or any campgrounds. Ms. Journey explained that they shoot from the boat ramp and nothing goes over the wildlife area or the camp grounds.

Sheriff Martin stated he did receive the copy of the application and his concerns are the same as Mr. Seewald. He stated there is a diagram in the application that shows the fall out and explained the requirements for the fall out area. Sheriff Martin asked what the size of shells will be that is not listed in the application with Ms. Journey stating the largest shell they shoot is 1.75. There was further discussion as to what fireworks can be shot off at the lake with Sheriff Martin stating that nothing can be shot that leaves the ground, and that they must have a permit like Ms. Journey is applying for. Commissioner Zwetzig asked what is being proposed for the fire safety, the Wiggins fire

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department has approved. Sheriff Martin stated he would assume that the Wiggins fire would be on site during the firework display. Mr. Seewald asked what time the display would be with Ms. Journey stating at 9:30 p.m. or 9:45 p.m...

Sheriff Martin asked how many shells will be shot off with Ms. Journey stating she was not sure, but that it would be mostly cakes a few small super cakes, that are 200 shots each but most are 10-25 shots. Sheriff Martin asked if at daylight if she checks the area for any live shells with Ms. Journey stating yes they do. Commissioner Zwetzig stated that even if the permit is approved today and there is a fire ban imposed the firework display will have to be canceled. Ms. Journey stated that is why she does not buy the insurance until closer to the event. Sheriff Martin stated there has not been any problems with the firework display in the past and sees no problem with this application. Mr. Seewald stated he does agree with Sheriff Martin that there has been no issues with the firework display prior. Commissioner Zwetzig asked if there is an alternative date, with Ms. Journey stating possibly September.

Chairman Arndt stated that the applicant will bring in the insurance by July 1st, 2020, with Ms. Journey agreeing to that date.

Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the Fireworks Display Permit, indicating the address as being 25402 County Road 3 Lot 82, Weldona CO 80653 for the display, stating the date and times of the permit with the notation that if there should be any fire ban in place, the permit will not be authorized with the applicant by Margaret Journey for Jackson Lake Village as outlined by Morgan County Administrative Services Karla Powell and authorized the Chair to sign with the contingency that Ms. Journey provide proof of liability insurance no later than July 1, 2020. Commissioner Zwetzig seconded the motion. Commissioner Zwetzig stated for record that there is a letter from the Wiggins fire submitted to the application .and motion carried 3-0.

RESOLUTION 2020 BCC 20

A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY GRANTING A USE BY SPECIAL REVIEW FOR A 24 INCH CRUDE OIL PIPELINE EXTENDING 24 MILES ACROSS PROPERTIES IN SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 60 WEST, SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 59 WEST, SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 58 WEST, AND SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 57 WEST, MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO AND GRANTING A VESTED RIGHTS PERIOD OF THREE YEARS

WHEREAS, Colorado Liberty Pipeline LLC (the “Applicant”) submitted an application for a special use permit to construct and install a 24 inch crude oil pipeline (the “Application”) located on properties in Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 60 West, Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 59 West, Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 58 West and Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 57 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, and more specifically described in **Exhibits A and B**, attached to this Resolution and incorporated by this reference (the “Properties”);

WHEREAS, the Applicant filed the Application on behalf of the owners of the Properties listed in **Exhibit A**;

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2020, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved with certain conditions;

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Applicant and the public; and

WHEREAS, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application, subject to certain conditions set forth herein.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:

1. APPROVAL.

The Application is hereby granted, subject to the conditions set forth herein, and as shown on the map, in **Exhibit B**, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this “Resolution” or the “Permit”).

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2. FINDING OF FACT.

Subject to the Applicant meeting and complying with all conditions set forth herein, the following findings are made:

- a. The use and its location as proposed are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan.

The Application meets the guidance in Chapter 8 of the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan, Utilities, Public Facilities and Services, Policy H10 which states that utility facilities are to be properly sited with due regard to environmental quality by minimizing impact to agricultural and other surrounding land uses, visual quality, physical and biological resources.

In addition, the Application meets Policy H11 of the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan which states that utility facility siting should consider consolidation with or joint tower use, paralleling of existing facilities where appropriate with regard to sound environmental planning, system reliability, structural integrity and where economically feasible. Some portions of the pipeline will share an existing right-of-way with Xcel Energy.

- b. All the application documents are complete and present a clear picture of how uses are to be arranged on the site or within Morgan County.
- c. The Site Plan conforms to the district design standards of these Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures. The Applicant has negotiated and execute easements with all landowners, with the exception on one landowner who it continues to negotiate with, who properties are crossed by the pipeline. The Applicant has obtained all necessary road crossing permits from Morgan County.
- e. The Application as proposed is compatible with the surrounding uses and adequately buffered as determined by the County. The proposed use will be compatible with the existing and surrounding uses through land reclamation processes following construction.
- f. The special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare as set by federal, state or county regulation, whichever is the strictest. The project has been designed and will be constructed and operated to conform to standards and procedures outlined by the U.S. Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.
- g. The special use proposed is not planned to be developed on a non-conforming parcel.
- h. The applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project, all pertinent technical information, adequate financial resources to implement it, and has paid all fees and review costs levied by the County for application processing and review. The project will serve current and forecasted market energy demand and will help supply the strategic petroleum reserve.
- i. For any special use requiring a supply of water that the applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability and in the case of human consumption, quantity, quality, and reliability. The water requirements during construction of the pipeline will be procured in accordance with applicable permitting, and are anticipated to be minimal for dust control and lubrication for horizontal direction drilling.

3. CONDITIONS.

The approval of the use by special review is conditioned upon the following:

- a. The Applicant will enter into a road use agreement in a form and substance acceptable to the County Attorney and the Morgan County Road & Bridge Department, prior to the commencement of construction activities.
- b. The pipeline area will be returned to its pre-construction condition as mutually agreed upon by the property owners and the Applicant.
- c. The Applicant shall obtain all permits necessary by the State of Colorado and federal agencies and shall remain in compliance with the requirements and conditions of those permits.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Owners and the Applicant.

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- b. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.
- c. The Applicant shall comply and ensure compliance by third parties with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.

5. VESTED RIGHTS.

This approval shall constitute a site specific development plan, pursuant to Sec. 2-440 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations and C.R.S. § 24-68-101 *et seq.*, and the County hereby grants vested rights for a period of three years.

Morgan County Planning and Zoning Director, Pam Cherry presented to the Board for Resolution 2020 BCC 20, Liberty Pipeline, a Resolution Conditionally Granting A Use By Special Review For A 24 Inch Crude Oil Pipeline. Ms. Cherry stated on February 10, 2020 the Planning Commission reviewed the application for the Colorado Liberty Pipeline, LLC, to be located south Morgan County and recommended approval to the Board of County Commissioners.
