A RESOLUTION GRANTING A USE BY SPECIAL REVIEW FOR EXPANSION OF A NON-CONFORMING STORAGE FACILITY LOCATED IN THE SW ¼ OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 58 WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO COMBINED LOTS 34 AND 35 OF BLOCK 1 OF THE TRAILSIDE PLANNED DEVELOPMENT, ADDRESSED AS 16295 COUNTY ROAD R, FORT MORGAN, COLORADO 80701

WHEREAS, Charles Greenwood III (the "Owner") has applied for a special use permit to allow the expansion of a non-conforming storage facility on Block 1, combined lots 34 and 35 of the Trailside Planned Development located in the SW ¼ of Section 2, Township 3 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, and addressed as 16295 County Road R, Fort Morgan, CO (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the application seeks approval of a special use permit for the following:

- 1. A new 180 x 50 foot storage building adjacent to an existing building on the northern portion of the Property;
- 2. The addition of storage units along the exterior of an existing building designated as Building 108; and
- 3. Additional outdoor storage to the north of an existing 40 x 70 foot building;

WHEREAS, these new structures and uses are shown on the site plan submitted by the Owner and attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and the approval set forth in this Resolution is limited to those structures and uses listed above;

WHEREAS, the proposed 120 x 60 foot building shown as a "Personal Shop" is not subject to the approval set forth herein, because it is a use-by-right and no special use permit is required for such a structure and use. In the event the structure is used for purposes other than a personal shop by the Owner and such use is not a use-by-right, Owner shall comply with the applicable Zoning requirements at the time, which may prohibit the use or require a special use permit;

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2020, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved with certain conditions:

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted at the Property;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Owner and the public; and

WHEREAS, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application, subject to certain conditions set forth herein.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:

1. APPROVAL

The application is hereby granted, subject to the conditions set forth herein. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this "Resolution" or the "Permit").

2. FINDINGS OF FACT

Subject to the Owner meeting and complying with all conditions set forth herein, the following findings are made:

- a. The use and its location are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan:
 - i. The project will encourage infill in existing business and industrial subdivision.
 - ii. The project is in proximity to activity centers and compatible with existing land use with access to established infrastructure.
- b. All the application documents are complete and present a clear picture of how uses are to be arranged on the site.
- c. The Site Plan conforms to the district design standards of these Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated by incorporating six foot privacy fencing to buffer this use from adjacent residential uses.
- e. The special use proposed has been made compatible with the surrounding uses and adequately buffered by the incorporation of 6 foot privacy fencing along the property lines

- f. This use poses only the minimum amount of risk to public health, safety and welfare.
- g. The Special Use is located on conforming parcel that is part of the Trailside Planned Development.
- h. The Owner has adequately documented a public need for the project in the form of increased economic development and providing a needed service in Morgan County. The Owner has submitted all pertinent technical information, adequate financial resources to implement the project, and has paid all County fees and review costs.
- i. The Owner has demonstrated that there is an existing Morgan County Quality Water tap which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity, quality and reliability.

3. CONDITIONS

The approval of the use by special review is conditioned upon the following:

- a. The Owner shall obtain necessary permits and comply with the requirements and conditions of those permits as determined by other governmental agencies with jurisdiction over this operation.
- b. The use of the approved structures shall be limited to private storage. Other uses, including without limitation manufacturing, workshop space, distribution (such as the drop off, pick up, or shipping of products, supplies, or materials) are prohibited and not hereby permitted.
- c. The uses for this property shall comply with the Trailside Planned Development Plan.
- d. A 6' privacy fence shall be constructed along the northern boundary of the Property where the "Proposed 6' Privacy Fence" is designated on the site plan and along the west side of the Property boundary adjacent to the retention pond where designated on the site plan. When the storage units are constructed along the outside of Building 108 (as designated on the site plan) the 6' privacy fence shall be extended along the entire west side of the Property boundary.
- e. The existing grain bins shall be removed.
- f. The retention pond shall be constructed as designed and shown in the Application and will include plans for mitigation of odors and pests.
- g. A lighting plan shall be submitted and approved by the Planning Administrator prior to installation of new lighting.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.

- c. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Owner, which are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- d. The Owner shall comply and ensure compliance by third parties with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.



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

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


Image of 5100 EX Electric Sander Controller


