



A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY GRANTING A USE BY SPECIAL REVIEW FOR A 24 INCH CRUDE OIL PIPELINE EXTENDING 24 MILES ACROSS PROPERTIES IN SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 60 WEST, SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 59 WEST, SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 58 WEST, AND SECTIONS 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 57 WEST, MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO AND GRANTING A VESTED RIGHTS PERIOD OF THREE YEARS

WHEREAS, Colorado Liberty Pipeline LLC (the “Applicant”) submitted an application for a special use permit to construct and install a 24 inch crude oil pipeline (the “Application”) located on properties in Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 60 West, Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 59 West, Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 58 West and Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of Township 1 North, Range 57 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, and more specifically described in **Exhibits A and B**, attached to this Resolution and incorporated by this reference (the “Properties”);

WHEREAS, the Applicant filed the Application on behalf of the owners of the Properties listed in **Exhibit A**;

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2020, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved with certain conditions;

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Applicant and the public; and

WHEREAS, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application, subject to certain conditions set forth herein.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:

1. APPROVAL.

The Application is hereby granted, subject to the conditions set forth herein, and as shown on the map, in **Exhibit B**, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this “Resolution” or the “Permit”).

2. FINDING OF FACT.

Subject to the Applicant meeting and complying with all conditions set forth herein, the following findings are made:

- a. The use and its location as proposed are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan.

The Application meets the guidance in Chapter 8 of the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan, Utilities, Public Facilities and Services, Policy H10 which states that utility facilities are to be properly sited with due regard to environmental quality by minimizing impact to agricultural and other surrounding land uses, visual quality, physical and biological resources.

In addition, the Application meets Policy H11 of the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan which states that utility facility siting should consider consolidation with or joint tower use, paralleling of existing facilities where appropriate with regard to sound environmental planning, system reliability, structural integrity and where economically feasible. Some portions of the pipeline will share an existing right-of-way with Xcel Energy.

- b. All the application documents are complete and present a clear picture of how uses are to be arranged on the site or within Morgan County.
- c. The Site Plan conforms to the district design standards of these Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures. The Applicant has negotiated and execute easements with all landowners, with the exception on one landowner who it continues to negotiate with, who properties are crossed by the pipeline. The Applicant has obtained all necessary road crossing permits from Morgan County.
- e. The Application as proposed is compatible with the surrounding uses and adequately buffered as determined by the County. The proposed use will be compatible with the existing and surrounding uses through land reclamation processes following construction.

- f. The special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare as set by federal, state or county regulation, whichever is the strictest. The project has been designed and will be constructed and operated to conform to standards and procedures outlined by the U.S. Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration.
- g. The special use proposed is not planned to be developed on a non-conforming parcel.
- h. The applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project, all pertinent technical information, adequate financial resources to implement it, and has paid all fees and review costs levied by the County for application processing and review. The project will serve current and forecasted market energy demand and will help supply the strategic petroleum reserve.
- i. For any special use requiring a supply of water that the applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability and in the case of human consumption, quantity, quality, and reliability. The water requirements during construction of the pipeline will be procured in accordance with applicable permitting, and are anticipated to be minimal for dust control and lubrication for horizontal direction drilling.

3. CONDITIONS.

The approval of the use by special review is conditioned upon the following:

- a. The Applicant will enter into a road use agreement in a form and substance acceptable to the County Attorney and the Morgan County Road & Bridge Department, prior to the commencement of construction activities.
- b. The pipeline area will be returned to its pre-construction condition as mutually agreed upon by the property owners and the Applicant.
- c. The Applicant shall obtain all permits necessary by the State of Colorado and federal agencies and shall remain in compliance with the requirements and conditions of those permits.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Owners and the Applicant.
- b. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.

- c. The Applicant shall comply and ensure compliance by third parties with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.

5. VESTED RIGHTS.

This approval shall constitute a site specific development plan, pursuant to Sec. 2-440 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations and C.R.S. § 24-68-101 *et seq.*, and the County hereby grants vested rights for a period of three years.
