The Board of Morgan County Commissioners met Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 9:09 a.m. with Chairman Mark Arndt, and Commissioner Laura Teague in attendance with Commissioner James Zwetzig being absent.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018 BCC 19

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO, DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE MORGAN COUNTY ASSESSOR TO APPROVE PROPERTY TAX REFUNDS OR ABATMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 OR LESS

WHEREAS, C.R.S § 39-1-113(1.5) authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to delegate the authority to the Morgan County Assessor to review and settle petitions for abatements or refund of property taxes in the amount of \$10,000 or less; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Board of County Commissioners that delegation of this authority to the Morgan County Assessor is in the best interests of Morgan County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners, Colorado, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County hereby delegates to the Morgan County Assessor the authority to review petitions for abatements or refunds and settle by written mutual agreement any such petition for abatement or refund in an amount of \$10,000 or less per tract, parcel or lot of land or per schedule of personal property.
2. All previous resolutions delegating this authority pursuant to C.R.S. § 39-1-113(1.5) are hereby repealed.

Chairman Arndt presented to the Board for approval, Resolution 2018 BCC 19 a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado, delegating authority to the Morgan County Assessor to approve property tax refunds or abatements in the amount of \$10,000 or less. Chairman Arndt stated that this follows through with state law that allows the Assessor to do this without having to go before the Board for a hearing and that it has been in effect for some time. This resolution will clean up a misprint in a resolution from 2009.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Resolution 2018 BCC 19, a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado, delegating authority to the Morgan County Assessor to approve property tax refunds or abatements in the amount of \$10,000 or less as presented by Chairman Arndt, and authorize the signatures approving the resolution. At this time, Chairman Arndt seconded the motion and the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 31 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 31, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road R (Road Segment 1700), starting approximately in the northwest corner of the intersection of County Road 24 and County Road R to place a new coolped cabinet at an existing site, trench west 6 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the coolped to the power meter then trench south 6 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit will be placed from the coolped to the existing handhole, for the purpose of installing a new coolped and conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$51.20 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Commissioner Teague noted that a clause be added to the permit which states that GIS shape files be provided if available, noting that this would be immensely helpful to the GIS department. She also wanted to be sure that the removal of all old facilities be made so as not to encumber the county with junk.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 31, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$51.20 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 32 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 32, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road 13 (Road Segment 2100), starting approximately 310 feet north of County Road U in the west Right of Way of County Road 13 to place a new coolped cabinet, trench north 18 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the coolped to the breaker box then trench northeast 14 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit will also be placed from the coolped to the existing hand hole, for installation of telecommunications equipment and conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$53.20 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 32, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$53.20 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 33 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 33, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road 15 (Road Segment 310), starting approximately 225 feet south from the southeast corner of County Road Q in the west Right of Way of County Road 15 to place a new coolped cabinet, trench southwest 17 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the coolped to the breaker box then trench northeast 9 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit from the coolped to the existing handhole, for installation of a new coolped and associated conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$52.60 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 33, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$52.60 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

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Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 34 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 34, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road N (Road Segment 1100), starting approximately in the northwest corner of the intersection of County Road 18 and County Road N to place a 4220 cabinet over an existing pedestal, trench east 60 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from a new power pole to the power cabinet, then trench north 5 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the power cabinet to the 4220, and trench south 10 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit from the hand hole to the 4220 cabinet, for installation of a new 4220 cabinet and associated conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$56.00 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Commissioner Teague asked for clarification whether this would cross over the road, with Mr. Goodman stating this was for the conduit only and that the roads will come later.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 34, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$56.00 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 35 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 35, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road R (Road Segment 1150), starting in the northeast corner of the intersection of County Road 21 and County Road R to place a new coolped cabinet, trenching south 3 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit from the handhole to the coolped, then trench south 3 feet of direct bury fiber tail, for installation of a new coolped and associated conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$50.60 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 35, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$50.60 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 36 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 36, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road W (Road Segment 1300), starting in the southwest corner of intersection of Highway 52 and County Road W to place a new coolped cabinet, trench north 20 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit to be placed from the hand hole to the coolped, then trench east 85 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the breaker box to the coolped cabinet, installation of a new coolped and associated conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$60.50 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Chairman Arndt asked whether there were any concerns about trenching this road as far as washing downhill. Mr. Goodman stated that he had no concerns as they were only going a short distance.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 36, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$60.50 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – RIGHT OF WAY - 2018 PMT 37 – Century Link

Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman presented to the Board for approval, a Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 37, with Century Link. Mr. Goodman stated this right of way permit is for trenching parallel to County Road 19 (Road Segment 900), starting approximately 435 feet south from the intersection of County Road N and County Road 19 in the west Right of Way to place a new coolped cabinet, trench south 20 feet of 2 inch schedule 80 conduit from the coolped to the breaker box, then trench south 6 feet of 2 inch schedule 40 conduit from the coolped to the handhole and trench east 4 feet of 10 pair CAT5E cable will be direct buried from the coolped to the cross box, for installation of a new coolped and associated conduit. He stated the fees are attached in the amount of \$53.00 and Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman inspected the location.

Ms. Waite commented to the board that the attached check is for more than the permits presented today and that the balance would be applied to the six on next week's agenda.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve Right of Way Permit 2018 PMT 37, with Century Link as outlined in the narrative of the and noting the fees in the amount of \$53.00 are attached as presented by Morgan County Road Supervisor John Goodman and authorized the Chair to sign with the addition of the GIS shape file clause. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – BID AWARD – RFP 2018-0621-001 Jail Security Electronics Upgrade

Morgan County Undersheriff, Dave Martin presented to the Board for approval of Bid Award RFP 2018-0621-001 Jail Security Electronics Upgrade. Undersheriff Martin stated he received three bids, from Cornerstone in the

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amount of \$356,977.00, CML Security in the amount of \$348,885.00 and Kubal Group in the amount of \$348,283.00. Undersheriff Martin outlined each bid and the details of each. He also stated that it was later determined to add additional cameras and that each of the three vendors submitted supplemental pricing. The supplemental pricing making the bid amounts for each as follows, from Cornerstone in the amount of \$379,486.00, from CML Security in the amount of \$366,407.00 and from Kubal Group in the amount of \$371,883.00. Martin pointed out that originally Kubal was the lowest bid by \$600.00 and with the additional cameras they are now roughly \$5,500.00 more than the lowest bid. He also stated that the maintenance contract is cheaper in the long run and that having done business with them in the past it is his recommendation that a contract be established with Kubal Group. He also noted that they currently provide the same service to Logan and to Washington counties and that his research shows that they provide excellent customer service.

Commissioner Teague asked when the work would begin. Undersheriff Martin stated that the start date would be early August and that it would likely be a three to four month project, hoping to be done before Thanksgiving. Commissioner Teague asked whether additional work would be required of the IT department. Ms. Kopetzky stated that the IT dept would assist with configuration and support. Chairman Arndt asked for clarification since the old cabling would be removed would there be additional costs for new placements of the cameras. Undersheriff Martin also pointed out that the amount budgeted for this project was \$400,000.00 and that it is coming in under budget. Commissioner Teague asked about portability of the system should the need arise to do substantial work to the Justice Center. Undersheriff Martin stated that it is his understanding that the system is moveable and that as it is computer based the anticipated life span would be similar to a computer.

At this time, Undersheriff Martin recommended the Board award the bid to purchase of jail security electronics to Kubal Group in the amount of \$371,883.00.

Chairman Arndt asked that it be noted that due to Undersheriff Martin's recommendation, this bid will be awarded instead of the low bid.

Commissioner Teague made a motion to approve bid award RFP 2018-0621-001 Jail Security Electronics Upgrade to Kubal Group in the amount of \$371,883.00 and authorized the preparation of a contract as outlined and recommended by Undersheriff Martin. Chairman Arndt seconded the motion and the motion carried 2-0.

COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated July 13, 2018 through July 24, 2018 with changes.

Pat Mendoza, Deputy Clerk to the Board, updated the Board regarding the new statewide DRIVES system that will be implemented in the motor vehicle department. Ms. Mendoza stated the department would be closed the first week in August for data conversion. Chairman Arndt added that it is important for the public to get time sensitive business completed prior to this closure.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

Being no further business the meeting was then adjourned at 9:24 a.m.
