#### RESOLUTION

#### 2018 BCC 31

#### A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2008 BCC 35

(A Resolution Granting a Use by Special Review for Expansion of a Livestock Confinement Facility located in Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, Colorado) with an address of 1473 County Road S, Wiggins, Colorado 80654)

**WHEREAS**, Empire Dairy, LLC (the "Owner") owns property located in Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, with the address of 1473 County Road S, Wiggins, Colorado (the "Property"), located in the Agriculture Production Zone District;

**WHEREAS**, the Property is subject to a Special Use Permit issued pursuant to Resolution 2008 BCC 35, which was dated September 30, 2008 *nunc pro tunc* to September 16, 2008;

**WHEREAS**, the Resolution 2008 BCC 35 approved an expansion of the dairy facility currently in existence on the Property allowing it to expand from 7,000 animal units to 20,000 animal units and construct an additional milking parlor;

WHEREAS, Resolution 2008 BCC 35 included a number of conditions, including the following:

<u>Section 3.a.iv.</u> Access from the facility onto County Road S shall be limited to three County approved driveways between County Road 2 and Highway 144. The remainder of the facility fronting County Road S shall be fenced off to reduce direct ingress and egress onto County Road S.

<u>Section 3.a.vi</u>. The applicant must at their own expense, pave County Road S, to meet County Standards, from County Road 2 to Highway 144. This can be done through grants noting that the applicant will be responsible for applying for the grants and meeting all requirements. This can be done through a County bid process, with applicant responsible for administrative cost. Applicant must notify the County of their plans for financing this project no later than May 1, 2009;

**WHEREAS**, Tim Naylor of AGPROfessionals, on behalf of the Owner, filed an application to amend Resolution 2008 BCC 35 (the "Application") to amend the two above-referenced conditions as follows:

<u>Section 3.a.iv</u>. Access from the facility onto County Road S shall be limited to nine driveways for access to the facility along County Road S between County Road 2 and Highway 144.

Section 3.a.vi. Delete entirely.

**WHEREAS,** on June 18, 2018 the Planning Commission held a properly noticed public hearing on the application and recommended approval subject to certain conditions;

**WHEREAS**, on August 16, 2018 the Board of County Commissioners held a properly noticed public hearing on the application and approved the application based on evidence and the recommendation for approval subject to conditions, as set forth in more detail herein; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado, after reviewing all relevant documents and hearing from the Applicant, staff and the public, and considering the criteria for amending special use permits as set forth in Sections 2-430 and 2-345 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations desires to amend Resolution 2008 BCC 35 as set forth herein.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO, as follows:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners find that:
- A. The use and its location as proposed are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan and will provide economic growth, utilize existing infrastructure and will protect existing agricultural operations.
  - i. The project broadens employment opportunities for residents and will further economic growth.
  - ii. The proposed use is compatible with existing land uses and there is access to established public infrastructure.
  - iii. The use will protect existing agriculture operations by allowing it to continue while not restricting private property rights.
- B. All the application documents are complete and present a clear picture of how uses are to be arranged on the site or within Morgan County. All necessary application documents were included in the original submittal package.
- C. The Site Plan conforms to the district design standards of Section 2-320 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
- D. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures.
- E. The special use is compatible with the surrounding uses and adequately buffered as determined by the County. Empire Dairy is adjacent to other Agriculture uses.
- F. The special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare as set by federal, state or county regulation, whichever is the strictest.
- G. The special use proposed is not to be developed on a non-conforming parcel.
- H. The Applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project, all pertinent technical information, and adequate financial resources to implement it, and has paid all fees and review costs levied by the County for application processing and review.
- I. The Applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability and in the case of human consumption, quantity, quality, and reliability.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby amends Resolution 2008 BCC 35 as follows:
- A. Section 3.a.iv is hereby amended to read as follows:

Access from the facility onto County Road S shall be limited to the eight driveways between County Road 2 and Highway 144, in the locations shown on the attached **Exhibit A**. The existing driveway, labeled as Entrance #9, nearest the intersection of County Road S and County Road 2, as shown on **Exhibit A**, shall be removed and fenced off. The remainder of the facility fronting County Road S shall be fenced off with fencing meeting the definition of a "lawful fence" as currently defined in C.R.S. § 35-46-101(1), which provides, in relevant part, as follows:

"Lawful fence" is a well-constructed three barbed wire fence with substantial posts set at a distance of approximately twenty feet apart, and sufficient to turn ordinary horses and cattle, with all gates equally as good as the fence, or any other fence of like efficiency.

B. Section 3.a.vi is deleted in its entirety

Granting a Use by Special Review for Expansion of a Livestock Confinement Facility located in Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 60 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado with an address of 1473 County Road S, Wiggins, Colorado 80654, signing nunc pro tunc, with Chairman Arndt seconding the motion and the motion carried 2-1, with Commissioner Zwetzig being the dissenting vote.

#### **COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS**

Sheriff Crone announced to the Board that his department will be participating in honoring Cancer Awareness month noting that Undersheriff Dave Martin has presented a couple of ideas on how their department can publicly express their support. Sheriff Crone had several officers at the meeting sporting a pink badge where they will wear these through the month of October to honor those who have been diagnosed and are survivors of various types of cancer. He stated his officers have also participated in "No Shave November" in the past where each officer that participated was required to pay a fee and the funds collected from these fees were then used to assist a family who was going through cancer treatments. This year, they are deciding to start this project now and not wait until November, stating they will be able to collect more funds to support others. At this time, Undersheriff Martin stated that all of the staff who will be wearing a pink badge, purchased the badge on their own and then asked to recognize some special ladies who were invited to the meeting for being "survivors" of breast cancer. Family members presented a "survivor" badge to each of their respective family members who were Mary Trout, Danette Martin and Diane Parks.

Chairman Arndt thanked the Sheriff and his staff for their support and for providing this recognition to show support of the community.
