**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
Minutes of Meeting  
May 7, 2019**

The Board of Morgan County Commissioners met Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman James Zwetzig, Commissioner Mark Arndt, Commissioner Jon Becker and County Attorney Kathryn Sellars in attendance. Chairman Zwetzig introduced some special guests in the audience today naming those individuals and then asked those individuals to lead the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA**

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to adopt the agenda noting one change under general business clarifying the agenda language to indicate Precinct 1 and Precinct 18 instead of Precinct 1 and Precinct 2, with Commissioner Becker seconding the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Foster Care Month Proclamation - 2019

Morgan County Department of Human Services Case Worker, Foster Care, Rachel Free, and Human Services Director Jacque Frenier presented to the Board for approval and recognition the Proclamation proclaiming May 2019 as May Foster Care Month. At this time, Ms. Free read the proclamation aloud.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to approve and recognize the Proclamation proclaiming May 2019 as Foster Care Month as presented by Morgan County Department of Human Services Case Worker, Foster Care, Rachel Free. Commissioner Becker seconded the motion and motion carried 3-0.

Discussion followed with Ms. Frenier stating they currently have approximately 25 children placed in foster care and provided information regarding the need for foster care families indicating there are 8 foster homes in the County at this time. She further spoke about those children needing higher levels of care and the concerns and issues the County faces at this time regarding recruitment for foster families. She stated they do host events that are in support of foster families to recognize those who have stepped up and serve in this role. Ms. Frenier mentioned the program, Family First, and the reasons for its implementation. Supportive remarks were made by each board member expressing their appreciation for those foster families serving our community.

**Consideration of Approval – RESOLUTION – 2019 BCC 09 – RESOLUTION DIVIDING VOTER PRECINCT NO. 1 IN MORGAN COUNTY INTO TWO PRECINCTS TO BE KNOWN AS PRECINCT NO. 1 AND PRECINCT NO. 18**

**RESOLUTION 2019 BCC 09**

**A RESOLUTION DIVIDING VOTER PRECINCT NO. 1 IN MORGAN COUNTY INTO TWO PRECINCTS TO BE KNOWN AS PRECINCT NO. 1 AND PRECINCT NO. 18**

**WHEREAS**, in 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”), acting pursuant to C.R.S. § 1-5-101(3), through Resolution 2016 BCC 06, approved the establishment of one voting precinct per every 2,000 active eligible electors;

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Clerk has notified the Board that the current number of active eligible electors in Precinct No. 1 is 1811;

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes that the number of active eligible electors may increase over the limitation of 2,000 by the presidential primary election in March 2020 and the general election in November 2020;

**WHEREAS**, to address this issue, the Morgan County Clerk has proposed the division of Precinct No.1, pursuant to C.R.S. § 1-5-101(5), into two precincts, a smaller Precinct No. 1 and a new precinct, Precinct No. 18, with such division based upon the addresses of the current active eligible electors;

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Clerk has consulted with the Colorado Secretary of State’s office in determining the division and numbering of the new precincts;

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Clerk has also conferred with the leadership of the County’s two major political parties and that leadership has concurred with the division of Precinct No. 1;

**WHEREAS**, the division of Precinct No. 1 does not constitute a redistricting and will only alter the locations where voters may cast their votes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board, acting pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 1-5-101(3) and 1-5-101(5), desires to divide Precinct No. 1 into two precincts to be known as Precinct No. 1 and Precinct No. 18.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. The new boundaries of Precinct No. 1 shall be as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto.
2. The boundaries of Precinct No. 18 shall be as shown on Exhibit B, attached hereto.

Morgan County Clerk and Recorder, Susan Bailey presented to the Board Resolution 2019 BCC 09 a Resolution Dividing Voter Precinct No. 1 in Morgan County into two precincts to be known as Precinct No. 1 and Precinct No. 18. Ms. Bailey stated in 2016, the Board approved the establishment of one voting precinct per every 2,000 active eligible electors and this resolution is now necessary given the number of active eligible electors may increase over the limitation of 2000 by the presidential primary election in March 2020 and the general election in November 2020. She stated the resolution was prepared by County Attorney Kathryn Sellars, who was present at the meeting for any questions the Board may have. Ms. Bailey further stated that pursuant to C.R.S. 1-5-101(5), this resolution has been prepared to propose the division of Precinct 1, into two precincts, a smaller Precinct No. 1 and a new Precinct No 18 with such division based upon the addresses of the current eligible electors. Precinct 1 will now be north of Morgan County Road P and Precinct 18 will be south of County Road P. She informed the Board she did meet with the chair of each major party regarding this proposal and both expressed agreement of the proposal. At this time, Ms. Bailey asked Election Manager, Pat Mendoza, to come forward to answer any questions the board had regarding the proposed division indicating that Ms. Mendoza worked diligently on where this division of Precinct 1 would be to be most practical and efficient. Ms. Bailey further indicated the number of active eligible electors as of May 6, 2019 was 1,811.

At this time, in response to Chairman Zwetzig's question regarding the legalities of the proposed resolution, County Attorney Kathryn Sellars provided an explanation of why this action is necessary at this time and further stated that upon the next census being completed, the data will then be reviewed to be sure the County's precinct numbers remain within the statutory requirements.

Commissioner Becker made the motion to approve Resolution 2019 BCC 09 a Resolution Dividing Voter Precinct No. 1 in Morgan County into two precincts to be known as Precinct No. 1 and Precinct No. 18, with the mentioned changes, noting the change in eligible electors from 1773 to 1811 and the change in presidential primary from June to March, as presented by Morgan County Clerk and Recorder, Susan Bailey. Commissioner Arndt seconded the motion. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.

**Consideration of Approval – BID AWARD – RFP 2019-0425-001 AWD Motor Grader**

Morgan County Public Works Director Bruce Bass presented to the Board for approval Bid Award RFP 2019-0425-001 AWD Motor Grader stating this was an approved budget item for 2019. Mr. Bass stated he received two bids from 4 Rivers Equipment LLC in the amount of \$460,988.00 and Wagner Equipment in the amount of \$381,855.46. Mr. Bass summarized each bid. At this time, Mr. Bass recommended that the Board award bid RFP 2019-0425-001 be awarded to Wagner Equipment in the amount of \$381,855.46.

In response to a question raised by Commissioner Becker regarding 4 Rivers Equipment and the buyback option, further discussion followed with Mr. Bass providing a detailed summary of what has occurred over the past four years. Commissioner Becker also asked about warranty work if it is completed onsite or items are shipped in, with Mr. Bass stating it is completed on site.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to approve bid award RFP 2019-0425-001 AWD Motor Grader to Wagner Equipment as recommended by Morgan County Public Works Director Bruce Bass in the amount of \$381,855.46 for two machines. Commissioner Becker seconded the motion the motion carried 3-0.

**Consideration of Approval – BID AWARD – RFP 2019-0425-002 Asphalt Paving Projects**

Morgan County Public Works Director Bruce Bass presented to the Board for approval Bid Award RFP 2019-0425-002 Asphalt Paving Projects. Mr. Bass stated these bids are in response to the approved 2019 budgeted asphalt paving projects. Mr. Bass stated he received four bids from PLM Asphalt and Concrete, LLC from Aurora, Colorado in the amount of \$2,086,265.00, Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. from Fort Collins, Colorado in the amount of \$1,908,161.00, McAttee Construction doing business as Simon from Sterling, Colorado in the amount of

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1,863,045.00 and Aggregate Industries – WCR, Inc. from Golden, Colorado in the amount of \$2,139,953.00. Mr. Bass summarized each bid reflecting each of the scheduled asphalt paving projects planned.

At this time, Mr. Bass requested the Board award this bid in two portions, the first being the County's portion in the amount of \$1,799,5335.00 and the second motion being the City's portion in the amount of \$63,510.00, contingent upon the acceptance of the bid by the City of Fort Morgan awarding the bid and a memorandum of understanding being prepared for both entities to agree to.

Upon further discussion, it was agreed that one motion could be made to award this bid at which time Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve bid award RFP 2019-0425-002 Asphalt Paving Projects to McAtee Construction doing business as Simon from Sterling, Colorado as recommended by Morgan County Public Works Director Bruce Bass in the total amount of \$1,863,045.00 noting that \$63,510.00 would be approved only upon the City's approval in a Memorandum of Understanding between the two entities. At this time, Commissioner Arndt seconded the motion and motion carried 3-0.

Morgan County Clerk and Recorder Susan L. Bailey presented to the Board a Liquor License or 3.2 Beer License Renewal Application submitted by Danette L. Garlis dba Elaine's Place for a Hotel and Restaurant (county) license. Ms. Bailey stated that she has received the necessary documents and all fees have been submitted. Ms. Bailey stated that there are no issues with this licensee and then asked the Morgan County Sheriff's Department to report at which time Sheriff Dave Martin indicated he had nothing to report. Ms. Bailey then asked the Board for approval.

Chairman Zwetzig opened the matter for public comment at which time no comment followed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Arndt to approve the liquor license renewal for Danette L. Garlis dba Elaine's Place indicating the address as 17590 County Road T.5, Fort Morgan, Colorado as presented by Morgan County Clerk and Recorder Susan L. Bailey and authorized the Chair to sign noting the fees are attached. Commissioner Becker seconded the motion and motion carried 3-0.

## **COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS**

At this time, Sheriff Martin performed the swearing in ceremony of four new deputies and further thanked the Board for the opportunity to conduct the ceremony in the Board's presence.

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated May 3, 2019 through May 14, 2019 with changes.
