

Notice of Coordinated Election – November 2, 2021
To the Electors of Morgan County
Pursuant to C.R.S. §1-5-205

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Coordinated Mail Ballot Election will be held in Morgan County, Colorado on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. Ballots will be mailed to **all active** voters the week of October 11, 2021. Voters may return voted ballots in person to 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan, CO during regular business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., by mail to PO Box 1399, Fort Morgan, CO 80701 or voters may use any of the secure ballot drop boxes located at the following locations: west of the Morgan County Administration Building in the alleyway, - 231 Ensign St in Fort Morgan; Brush City Hall - 600 Edison St in Brush; Wiggins Town Hall - 304 Central Ave in Wiggins.

IMPORTANT: The Self Affirmation on the Mail Ballot Envelope MUST BE SIGNED by the voter. **Please use black or blue ink ONLY** to mark your ballot. Additionally, on the voter label if there is an “ID REQUIRED” symbol, be sure to enclose a copy of your ID with your ballot. Your ballot will not count unless ID is provided.

All VOTED ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder’s Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, November 2, 2021. **Postmarks do not count.** Please affix adequate postage to return ballot by mail.

Sample ballots will be available at the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder’s Office at 231 Ensign Street, Fort Morgan, CO or on the website at morgancounty.colorado.gov.

Updates to voter registration: To check or change your voter registration, visit www.govotecolorado.gov or contact the Morgan County Clerk and Recorder’s office at 970-542-3521, option 5. Note that Colorado is a same-day-registration state, which means voters can register or update their voter registration all the way through Election Day at 7 p.m.

Monday, October 25, 2021 is the last day you may submit a written application to have a ballot mailed to you. Ballots may be obtained by the voter in person at the Clerk and Recorder’s Office through Election Day Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

In accordance with EAC Advisory 2007-001: Accessible voting systems for in-person voting, the Morgan County Administration Building, 231 Ensign Street 1st Floor, Fort Morgan, will be open for electors wishing to utilize the DAU (Disabled Access Unit) voting machine. This Voter Service Polling Center will be open for the 2021 Coordinated Election in Morgan County, beginning on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 through Monday, November 1, 2021 during regular business hours of Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturday, October 30, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Election Day, November 2, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
