#### Consideration of Approval - RFP 2021-1230-002 Jackson Lake Water Share Bid Tabulation and Award

Morgan County Administrative Services Manager, Karla Powell presented to the Board RFP 2021-1230-002 Jackson Lake Water Share Bid Tabulation and Award. Ms. Powell stated that they received two bids one from Fort Morgan Water Company, LTD in the amount of \$501.00 and a second bid from Bijou Irrigation Company, in the amount of \$167,000.00. Ms. Powell stated that Bijou Irrigation Company has since withdrawn their bid, they were under the understanding that they were purchasing the share not leasing the shares.

At this time, Ms. Powell recommended the bid be awarded to Fort Morgan Water Company, LTD in the amount of \$501.00. The contract will be from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. Ms. Powell stated Fort Morgan Water Company, LTD. has leased this share in the past.

Morgan County Election Specialist, Pat Mendoza presented to the Board for approval Resolution 2022 BCC 06, a Resolution Affirming The Established Precints In Morgan County And The Number Of Active Eligible Electors For Each Precinct. Ms. Mendoza stated Precinct boundaries are changed following the decennial census to allow for growth within the county. Statute requires that a precinct boundary be changed when the active voter count within a precinct reaches 1500 or 2000 with board approval. At this time, none of Morgan County's 18 precincts has reached that threshold so that is why we are seeking approval affirming the current precinct boundaries as they are currently drawn.

Commissioner Arndt made the motion to approve Resolution 2022 BCC 06, a Resolution Affirming The Established Precints In Morgan County And The Number Of Active Eligible Electors For Each Precinct as presented by Morgan County Election Specialist, Pat Mendoza . Commissioner Westhoff seconded the motion and motion carried 3-0.

### Consideration of Approval – 2022 MORGAN COUNTY FEE SCHEDULE

Morgan County Administrative Services Manager Karla Powell presented to the Board for approval, the 2022 Morgan County Fee Schedule. Ms. Powell stated she made contact with all departments and indicating there were four departments that had changes. Ms. Powell explained that on page 10 of the fee schedule the Fairgrounds fees were reviewed by the Board and there were a few changes that were needed. To rent the event center the previous amount was \$350.00 and has be changed to \$600.00 per day, there is a new event option they are able to rent from Friday at noon to Sunday noon for \$1,000.00, damage security deposit went from \$500.00 to \$1,500.00. In the multi-purpose building the previous amount was \$250.00 per day and has been changed to \$400.00 per day with the damage deposit changing from \$300.00 to \$600.00. The 4-H Building was previously \$250.00 and has been changed to \$400.00 per day with the damage deposit previously being \$300.00 is now \$600.00. The indoor and outdoor arenas the only change was the damage deposit which was previously \$125.00 and is now \$300.00.

Ms. Powell stated that on page 13 of the fee schedule there are some new fees that were presented in November 2021 with Resolution 2021BCC 33, the amended plats at \$400.00, all other amended plats are \$200.00, plat correction for \$200.00, re-plat for \$400.00, plat vacation for \$400.00 that is for no public infrastructure or dedication, plat vacation for public infrastructure or dedication is also \$400.00 and the temporary uses and structure is \$200.00. Ms. Powell explained that these are all new fees for the Planning and Zoning Department.

Ms. Powell explained that on page 17 of the fee schedule the Road and Bridge department moving permits are now a combination permit in the amount \$25.00.

Ms. Powell stated that on page 21 of the fee schedule the Solid Waste department semi tires are \$10.00 each plus weight, with rims are \$15.00 each plus weight. Also, the minimum fee went from \$9.00 to \$10.80.

Commissioner Westhoff made the motion to approve the 2022 Morgan County Fee Schedule as outlined and presented by Morgan County Administrative Services Manager Karla Powell with Commissioner Arndt seconding the motion noting the fees that were added in Planning and Zoning there are new processes that were developed to make it easier for citzens to get through the planning and zoning process. Chairman Becker stated that the increase in tire fee was because the County's fee from the company that picks up the tires increased as well. At this time motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to move the Treasurer's 4th Quarter Report to General Business and Administrative Items, with Commissioner Westhoff seconding the motion, motion carried 3-0.

### Treasurer's Quarterly Report – 2021 4th Quarter

Morgan County Treasurer and Public Trustee, Bob Sagel presented to the Board the Treasurer's 4th Quarter Report. Mr. Sagel summarized the report and provided documentation reflecting the data.
