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GENERAL BUSINESS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Consideration of Approval – Finance Department Audit Report

Morgan County Finance Director Dusty Corliss presented to the Board for approval the Morgan County Comprehensive Annual Report for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024. Mr. Corliss introduced Kelly Watson with Watson, Coon and Ryan who appeared remotely.

Ms. Watson spoke about how smooth the audit went with a minimum of issues. She commented on the background of the audit and how and why it's done. She stated that it took a bit longer than usual with the changes in leadership in the Finance department. She noted the County is in a strong financial position, with no downturn in the near future. She stated that one minor concern is the size of the Treasurer's department. She explained that it's difficult to separate duties as in a best case scenario.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to approve the audit report as presented by auditors Kelly Watson with Watson, Coon and Ryan, with Chairman Pro-Tem Westhoff seconding the motion. At this time, the motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – Morgan County Government Personnel Policy

Morgan County Human Resources Director Tracy Amen presented to the Board for approval the updated 2022 Morgan County Government Personnel Policy. Ms. Amen stated the elected officials were given the opportunity to provide input and recommendations along with the county attorney.

She stated the majority of changes were updates because of Colorado law changing and the changing of internal documents. Additionally, there were changes to the rehire policy with employees that are rehired within six months of their departure date receiving the same pay and PTO as when they left. She also explained that any part time employee that becomes a fulltime employee will have their sick leave automatically turned into PTO.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to accept the 2022 Morgan County Government Personnel Policy as presented by Human Resources Director Tracy Amen dated October 18, 2022. Chairman Pro-Tem Westhoff seconded the motion and motion carried 2-0.

RESOLUTION 2022 BCC 23

A RESOLUTION AMENDING A USE BY SPECIAL REVIEW FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A LIVESTOCK CONFINEMENT FACILITY LOCATED IN THE S1/2 AND THE E1/2NE1/4 OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 57 WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO AND GRANTING VESTED RIGHTS

WHEREAS, Kraft Family Dairies, LLC (the "Applicant") has an existing special use permit granted by Resolution 2006 BCC 21 for a livestock confinement facility (the "Application") located in the S½ and in the E½NE¼ of Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 57 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado and addressed as 13500 County Road 21, Fort Morgan, Colorado (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Applicant has applied for amendment to the special use permit to increase allowed animal units from 9875 animal units to 15,000 animal units, and installation of an additional parlor, two free stalls, and a dry pen within the existing footprint of the dairy operations;

WHEREAS, the Applicant has concurrently applied for vested rights associated with the Application for period of eight (8) years;

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2022, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved;

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) held a duly noticed public hearing on the Application;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing, the Board received testimony and evidence from the Owner, Morgan County staff and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve the Application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:

1. APPROVAL

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- a. The Application is hereby granted. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this “Resolution” or the “Permit”).
- b. The County approves vested rights for a period of eight (8) years from the date of approval of this Resolution.

2. FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board, having reviewed the application, all information provided and testimony heard, finds that:

- a. The use and its location as proposed are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. Specifically:

The property is located in the south central planning area as defined by the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. The area south of County Road Q remains agriculture and there are livestock confinement facilities that must be protected and allowed to expand. In this area Comprehensive Plan goals include:

Preserve and protect existing agricultural uses south of County Road Q.

The request to amend the 2006 special use permit will encourage the preservation and continuation of the industry.

- b. The application documents are complete and present a clear picture of how the use is to be arranged on the site.
- c. The Site Plan conforms to the district design standards of Section 2-420 and Section 4-200 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvement, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures.

The operation is existing and the additional impacts are expected to be minimal. Proposed use impacts upon existing uses are detailed in the included Nuisance Control Plan and in the Preliminary Environmental System Design.

- e. The special use proposed has been made compatible with the surrounding uses and is adequately buffered from any incompatible uses by distance and topography.

Buffering from adjacent agricultural uses is not necessary as the proposed improvements will be within the existing dairy footprint.

- f. The special use poses no or minimal risk to the public health, safety and welfare.
- g. The amended special use proposed is located on a conforming parcel.
- h. The applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project. The applicant has submitted all pertinent technical information, has demonstrated that it has adequate financial resources to implement the project, and has paid all County fees and review costs.
- i. The applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability.

3. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Applicant.
- b. The Applicant shall comply with all governmental and regulatory agency requirements and permits, including without limitation those promulgated for the protection of health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Morgan County. Such compliance shall include without limitation compliance with the regulations of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, the Colorado Department of Agriculture, and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.
- c. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.
- d. This Applicant shall comply with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.

WHEREAS, Dola Smith (Owner) owns property located in the E½SE¼ of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 56 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, also known as 15089 County Road 26 and 15115 County Road 26, Brush, Colorado 80723 (Property);

WHEREAS, Gary and Deb Vondy (Applicants) has submitted an application for a two-lot minor subdivision pursuant to the County’s Subdivision Regulations (the “Application”);

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2022, the Morgan County Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on the application;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing, the Planning Commission received testimony and evidence from the Applicant, Morgan County staff and the public and recommended conditional approval;

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) held a duly noticed public hearing on the Application;

WHEREAS, during the public hearing, the Board received testimony and evidence from the Applicant, Morgan County staff and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to conditionally approve the Application.

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:

- 1. The Board, having reviewed the application, all information provided and testimony heard, finds that, subject to the conditions set forth in this Resolution:
 - A. The application documents are complete and represent how the subdivision will be laid out including infrastructure, easements and access.
 - B. The subdivision is in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan and there is access to established public infrastructure.
 - C. The subdivision is compatible with surrounding land uses.
- 2. The Board hereby approves the Vondy Minor Subdivision, located in the E½SE¼ of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 56 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado subject to the following conditions:
 - A. The Water Use, Ownership and Well Sharing Agreement shall be amended to include the following provisions:
 - i. Language addressing severing of the agreement if one of the owners ceases or desires to cease use of the well and providing for the full transfer of the ownership and maintenance obligations; and
 - ii. Express authority for the owner of Lot 2 to relocate the water line to the well if for any reason the right to have the water line on the property, identified by Book 760, Page 40, on the Vondy Minor Subdivision Plat, is challenged or otherwise not established by law.
 - B. The shared well agreement must be executed and recorded contemporaneously with the minor subdivision plat.

Morgan County Zoning Planning and Zoning Administrator, Nicole Hay presented to the Board for approval Resolution 2022 BCC 024, a Resolution Granting A Two-Lot Minor Subdivion Known As The Vondy Minor Subdivision. Ms. Hay stated that on September 12, 2022, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on an application from Gary and Deb Vondy and Dola Smith., for a two-lot Minor Subdivision to be known as Vondy Minor Subdivision located in the E½SE¼ of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 56 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado. Also known as 15089 County Road 26 and 15115 County Road 26, Brush, Colorado 80723. The Planning Commission recommended conditional approval on a vote of 5-0, 2 members were absent. On October 4, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners considered the application and conditionally approved it unanimously. Resolution 2022 BCC 24 reflects the outcome of that hearing.

Commissioner Arndt made the motion to approve Resolution 2022 BCC 024, a Resolution Granting A Two-Lot Minor Subdivion Known As The Vondy Minor Subdivision as presented by Morgan County Zoning Planning and Zoning Administrator, Nicole Hay. Chairman Pro-Tem Westhoff seconded the motion and motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-001 Earthworks

Morgan County Solid Waste Director, Cass Yearous, presented to the Board for approval Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-001 Earthworks. Mr. Yearous explained he received four bids, a bid from Elevated Excavating in the amount of \$571,222.07, a bid from RCD Construction in the amount of \$399,950.66, a bid from Melvin Geib in

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the amount of \$297,792.66 and a bid from AB Underground in the amount of \$282,811.15. Mr. Yearous further summarized the details of each bid submitted.

At this time, Mr. Yearous recommended the bid be awarded to Melvin Geib, Inc. for \$297,792.66.

Chairman Pro-Tem Westhoff asked for more background on the work that has been done in the past for the county by Melvin Geib, Inc. Mr. Yearous stated that they had a very positive relationship with the company in the past.

Commissioner Arndt noted the price difference between the two lowest bids but stated the positive relationship with the company as well as the previous work done should be considered.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to accept the Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-001 Earthworks to Melvin Geib, Inc, as recommended by Morgan County Solid Waste Director, Cass Yearous, with Chairman Pro-Tem Weshoff seconding the motion. At this time motion carried 2-0.

Consideration of Approval – Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-002 Fuel

Morgan County Public Works Director, Bruce Bass, presented to the Board for approval Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-002 Fuel. Mr. Bass explained he received two bids, a bid from CHS High Plains in the amount of \$53,675.00 and a bid from Hill petroleum in the amount of \$18,825.00. Mr. Bass further summarized the details of each bid submitted.

At this time, Mr. Bass recommended the bid be awarded to Hill petroleum stating that the county has used them in the past with no issues and noted the much lower price.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to accept the Bid Tabulation and Award RFP 2022-1006-002 Fuel to Hill petroleum, as recommended by Morgan County Public Works Director, Bruce Bass, with Chairman Pro-Tem Westhoff seconding the motion. At this time motion carried 2-0.

COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Legislative Update – Darlene Carpio, Regional Director for Congressman Ken Buck

Darlene Carpio, Regional Director representing Congressman Ken Buck’s Office provided a Legislative Update to the Board.

Commissioner Arndt stated that the food stamp program that was introduced under Covid is very costly and has run its course, in his opinion. Ms. Carpio stated that she agreed and that there are ongoing discussions on the timing of the end of the program but with nothing immediate.

Dustin Corliss, Finance Director stated that there is a preliminary budget available in the Commissioner’s office and that a budget hearing will be held November 15th.

Kevin Strauch, Clerk and Recorder stated that ballots were mailed October 17th, drop boxes at the Brush City Hall, Wiggins Town Hall, the Elections Office, and the Morgan County Administration building are also open and available for ballots to be deposited. He also noted that a Voter Service and Polling Center will be open October 24th in the Elections Office.

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated October 14, 2022 through October 25, 2022 with changes.

Being no further business the meeting was then adjourned at 10:55 a.m.
