

SOLICITATION FOR NAMING RIGHTS PETITIONS HOG AND SHEEP BARN AT THE MORGAN COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Morgan County is accepting petitions for naming rights in consideration for the new hog and sheep barn at the Morgan County Fairgrounds. The new hog and sheep barn is scheduled to be completed by March 2026.

Only petitions for naming rights in consideration will be accepted. The County is not currently accepting petitions for naming rights in recognition for this facility. Requirements and Limitations:

- 1. Minimum consideration level: \$200,000.00, financial consideration only, no in-kind consideration.
- 2. Companies or individuals seeking naming rights must be a business located in Morgan County or resident of Morgan County.
- 3. Please include the desired length of naming rights and proposed payment schedule for consideration, if applicable.
- 4. Petitions may include drawings of proposed signage or other means to display name or logo of petitioner.
- 5. The County reserves the right to engage sponsors for facilities and areas located inside the hog and sheep barn.
- 6. The County may consider participation in fair activities depending on the consideration as part of the naming rights agreement.

Naming rights will be governed by an agreement entered into between the successful petitioner and the County. If the successful petitioner and the County cannot reach an agreement, the County may solicit new petitions.

Construction plans for the hog and sheep barn may be reviewed through the Commissioners' Office.

<u>Due Date for Petition</u>: 4 p.m. on October 31, 2025. Petitions received after this due date will be rejected.

Petitions may be submitted electronically to bccadmin@co.morgan.co.us or dropped off at the Commissioners' Office. Petitions are confidential until the petition opening to be scheduled after the due date and noticed on a Board of County Commissioner agenda. Petitioners will receive prior written notice of the petition opening date.
